FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How will you match me up with a roommate?

If you have a specific roommate in mind, make sure that both of you mutually request each other as roommates on the housing application. We also recommend that you submit your housing applications together. We will do our best to honor your request, if both students make the request. If you do not have a specific roommate in mind, roommates will be matched by the Housing and Residence Life Office according to smoking preference.

Are the residence halls co-ed?

The units are co-ed by floor and not by room.

Does my financial aid cover housing?

After you have paid for your classes and books, any money remaining from your financial aid can be applied towards your housing.

What about meal plans?

We do not offer meal plans to our housing residents. However, we do have a cafe in the academic building that is open during school hours. Also each unit has a fully equipped kitchen.

Can I stay on campus during holidays and spring break?

Yes, after notifying the appropriate housing personnel, you may stay in your unit during breaks. However, food services may not be available.

Is there additional storage besides the apartment unit?

There is no additional storage. All personal property must be stored in the student's individual housing unit.

Does Davenport have family housing?

Davenport does not offer family housing.

SECURITY

A safe and secure environment is Davenport's number one priority for its students. Our residence halls are wired for key card access. The University also provides campus safety officers who are on-duty 24 hours a day; patrolling the parking lots, residence halls, and all other campus facilities. Security will escort students during evening hours upon request. Our officers are uniformed, carrying a cellular phone and radio, making them easily accessible to the campus community.

STAFFING

The residence halls are staffed with live-in professional staff and student workers 24 hours a day. Our staff is on hand to help students make the adjustment from home life to campus life. The residence life staff works closely with Campus Safety, Career and Academic Advising, Career Services, and the Student Life Office as a means to extend the educational and social experience beyond the classroom.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a full-time Davenport student
- Must stay the entire academic year (2 semesters, not including summer)
- Must agree to an alcohol and smoke free environment
- Must abide by the D.U. Housing Handbook and Agreement, Student Code of Conduct
- Pets are not allowed, except for fish

COSTS

There is a \$150.00 fee due with your housing application. In addition, there is a \$150.00 refundable security deposit due with the housing agreement.

Housing agreements are for one academic school year. Prior to moving in, the semester must be paid in full.

Single = \$3,150.00 per semester (limited availability)
This is a unit in which the resident has his/her own living space and bedroom.

Double = \$2,625.00 per semester (limited availability)
This is a unit in which the resident shares a living space with one other resident but has his/her own bedroom.

Quad = \$2,225.00 per semester
This is a unit in which the resident shares a living space with three other residents but has his/her own bedroom.
