1: Supply Chain Management Fundamentals

- Understand the strategic role of operations in all types of organizations
- Review supply chain management across the end-to-end supply chain

2: Supply Chain Strategies

- Explore issues related to procurement, operations and logistics

- Review inventory strategies: Just in Time or Just in Case

3: Performance Measurement and Quality

Process Improvement Proposal Project

Training participants will complete a process improvement proposal throughout the course. The process improvement proposal will include the following components:

1.) The event or condition that signals a potential process improvement need/opportunity;

2.) A problem/opportunity statement;

3.) The root cause;

4.) An overview of the improvement plan and objectives;

5.) Qualitative/quantitative criteria for success.
