



- DU Student Connection Login Info**
Locate your DU username, email address and Student ID (temporary password) in your acceptance letter. You will need this login for all DU student access.
- Complete Financial Aid Application: Initial Steps**
 - FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) www.fafsa.gov (DU code: 002249)
 - Apply for additional scholarships: DU Foundation, Community Leaders Scholarship, DU Discount programs and local scholarships. Details: davenport.edu/scholarships.
- May 1st: Accept Offer of Admission/Confirm Enrollment**
Confirm your intent to start at Davenport University by accepting your offer of admission at davenport.edu/4U. Complete as soon as possible for priority enrollment.
- Register for Orientation/Class Scheduling**
 - Attending W.A. Lettinga (Main Campus)
Register for New2DU Orientation held during the spring/summer. This is a requirement for all incoming freshman. During orientation you will register for classes, meet faculty, have your DU ID picture taken and more. Register at davenport.edu/orientation
 - Attending a local Davenport campus
Contact your admissions representative to schedule a 1:1 meeting with an advisor to plan your class schedule. You should also register for the new student orientation scheduled at your campus at davenport.edu/orientation.
- Submit Housing Application & Deposit**
Freshmen are encouraged to live on-campus (Main Campus only). Apply for housing and pay the \$175 deposit at davenport.edu/housing after January 1st of senior year. Early application/ deposit is encouraged for preferred placement.

AFTER SENIOR YEAR:

- Arrange Testing for English and Math Placement**
Set up assessment testing for course placement and early credit opportunities.
- Submit Early Credit Documents**
Many students are able to earn early credit for college at Davenport. Submit the following documents for review: AP Credit (www.collegeboard.org), IB credit (SL and HL levels accepted) www.ibo.org, Articulation Credit (High School or Career Tech Center) davenport.edu/articulation and/or CLEP/DSST testing davenport.edu/testing.
- Complete Financial Aid: Final Steps**
 - Student Loan application: www.studentloans.gov. Complete Entrance Counseling and
 - Master Promissory Note. Parents can also apply for PLUS loans at the same site.
 - Accept Financial Aid: Scholarships, grants and student loans must be accepted to be applied to your student account. (Link on the Student Connection)
 - Submit requested documents to financial aid counselors in timely manner.
- Complete the Payment Process**
ALL students must finalize payment arrangements to keep classes. If you do not complete the payment process your courses will be dropped from your schedule prior to the beginning of the semester. Follow the directions in the "Financial Tools" section of the Student Connection.
- Purchase Books**
You should have your books before the first class meets. To purchase books, visit the W.A. Lettinga bookstore, click on "Online Bookstore" in your Student Connection page or order online: davenport.textbookx.com.
- Panther Prowl & Convocation**
