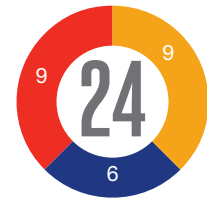


Take your project management experience to the next level. With Davenport's University's Project Management training programs you can develop a high-performance culture where projects are completed more efficiently and effectively.

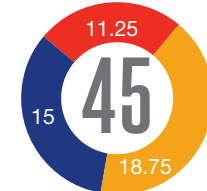

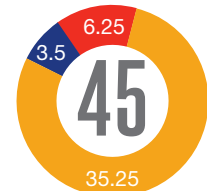

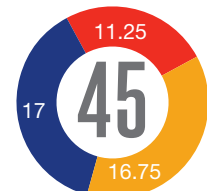
PROJECT SCHEDULING WITH AGILE

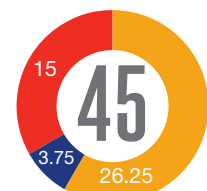
PROJECT LEADERSHIP IN AN OPERATIONS ENVIRONMENT

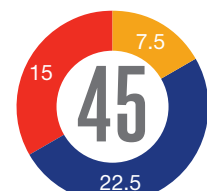
PROJECT QUALITY MANAGEMENT
