### Requirements for PMP Certification:

PMP candidates must have completed a bachelor's degree (or the equivalent) in any major, 35 hours of project management education, and a minimum of 3 years of related work experience – at least 4,500 hours guiding and managing projects.

Individuals with a high school diploma (or equivalent) but less than a bachelor's degree are still eligible for PMP certification, but require 35 hours of professional education and a minimum of 5 years of experience – at least 7,500 hours guiding and managing projects.
